

Church Function Gravitational Assessment

Answer each of the following questions based on your current activity. Avoid the temptation to mark the anticipated “spiritual” response if it is not your normal practice. You will score the assessment on the following page.

1. I have shared my story of Jesus in my life to at least one individual this calendar year.
2. In my spare time I read and study material that will help me to be a better follower of Christ.
3. I enjoy being around other people.
4. Doing something anonymously for someone else brings satisfaction and joy to me.
5. At least one of my preset radio buttons in my car is set to a Christian station that I listen to regularly.
6. When giving something to another person in need I feel compelled to share of God’s love with them.
7. I study/read my Sunday School lesson material each week before coming to class.
8. Some of my favorite memories involve a service project with other believers.
9. Seeing the expression on someone’s face after they have received a gift of grace brings joy to my heart.
10. I often find myself singing Christian songs when I am alone.
11. I appreciate being asked to share my faith at church events and missions projects.
12. I am actively attending a Sunday School or small group Bible study class to improve my spiritual walk.
13. In the past 60 days I have had other church members (not family) in my home for a meal or entertainment.
14. I enjoy working on and completing service projects alone.
15. Other than meal times I set aside a part of the day to engage in prayer, communing with God.
16. At a church function, I look for new people and make the effort to spend time with them.
17. I have at least one person I communicate with at least weekly to spiritually strengthen me and hold me accountable.
18. In the past 30 days I have been out to eat with church members, other than family.
19. In the past 90 days I have used my gifts, talents, and resources to provide for someone without expecting anything in return.
20. At least once a week I randomly break out in singing and praising God.

To score your Church Function Gravitation Assessment you will place a 1 or a 0 in the block to the right of each numbered block. The numbers in the blocks represent the corresponding question in the assessment. For each question you answered yes place a 1 in the corresponding box. Place a 0 in the boxes corresponding to the questions you answered “No” in the assessment. See example.
