TAKE HOME PACKET INSTRUCTIONS

Three verse activities are provided for families to do together over the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday breaks.

These can be provided in a gift bag with the three verse activities with instructions, devotion, and supplies in a separate Ziploc® bag.

The three verses that will be learned are:

- **1 Thessalonians 5:18**

CSB – give thanks in everything; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.

ESV – give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

KJV – In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

- **Ephesians 2:8**

CSB – For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God’s gift –

ESV – For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,

KJV – For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God:

- **1 Peter 4:9**

CSB – Be hospitable to one another without complaining.

ESV – Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.

KJV – Use hospitality one to another without grudging.

Thanksgiving – 1 Thessalonians 5:18 – Pinecone Turkey

Supplies Needed:

Pinecone (gather from your yard or neighborhood)
Cardstock with feathers and turkey head
Sharpie
Scissors

Instructions:

1. Find a pine cone in your yard or somewhere in your neighborhood. You can take a walk as a family to locate one and talk about all the things you are thankful for that you see as you search for the perfect pine cone.
2. Find a pinecone in your yard or somewhere in your neighborhood. You can take a walk as a family to locate one and talk about all the things you are thankful for that you see as you find the perfect pinecone.
3. Write a phrase of the verse on a different feather; include the reference.
4. Cut out the feathers and turkey head.
5. Place the feathers with the verse written on them in the pinecone.
6. Add the turkey head to complete the pinecone turkey.
7. Have each family member say the verse. Leave the turkey in a prominent place where you can review the verse each day.

Be Hospitable – 1 Peter 4:9 – Spoon Toss

Supplies Needed:

Spoons (enough for 2 sets)
Sharpies (2 different colors)

Instructions:

1. Write each word of the verse on each spoon; include the reference.
2. Do this again with the other color of marker.
3. Divide your family into two teams. Throw the spoons up in the air and allow the teams to work together to put their set of spoons in order. Play until everyone in the family can say the verse.

Christmas – Ephesians 2:8 – Ornament

Supplies Needed:

Plastic Clear Ornament
Strips of Christmas Craft Paper
Sharpie
Christmas Ribbon
Tag

Instructions:

1. Write phrases of the verse onto the strips of Christmas craft paper.
2. Place the paper strips in the Christmas ornament where the words can be seen.
3. Close the ornament.
4. Write the verse reference on the tag and tie it onto the ornament with the Christmas ribbon.
5. Hang the ornament on your Christmas tree.
