1.	Is there someone at the door to greet visitors and members?
2.	Are adults in the meeting room rather than the hallway at starting time?
3.	Is the environment conducive to learning – arrangement of chairs, visuals, and music?
4.	Do the people relate well together, is the fellowship strong?
5.	Does the teacher do something to help create learning readiness?
6.	Are the learners involved in discussion rather than the teacher doing most of the talking?
7.	Does the teacher see his/her role as a leader of discovery rather than dispenser of facts?
8.	Does the teacher seem more oriented toward teaching <i>people</i> the Bible rather than just teaching the Bible?
9.	Are items from the resource kit and other visuals in use?
10	Is there evidence of prior preparation?
11	Are a variety of teaching methods used?
12	Is good use made of time?
13	Is there time at the end of the lesson for application?
