Nine Things A Good Sunday School Leader Must Do

Every Good Sunday School leader must . . .

1. Have a deep **passion** for God and His Word.

- 2. Be very **positive** in their approach with people.
- 3. Evaluate their decisions on teaching styles and procedures based on the needs of their class members.
- 4. Continually ask the question, what can I do to become a better **teacher** and **pastor** to my class?
- 5. Be willing to take **small steps** in leading their class toward reaching the goal of Christ-likeness.
- 6. <u>Humbly</u> live a life that upholds the <u>values</u> and <u>teachings</u> of scripture.
- 7. Minister to the **needs** of their class members.
- 8. **Know** the Truth, **Live** the Truth, **Teach** the Truth.
- 9. Give God **glory** in every situation.

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
