## Tools for Evangelism

Even the best, most expensive tools are only good when we use them. What are some tools that every believer has access to that enable us to share our faith? 1 Peter 3:15 helps us see **five tools for sharing Christ**:

*“But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.” 1 Peter 3:15 (NIV)*

1. **My Heart**—“But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord...”

**Keep Christ in First Place in every part of your life!**

*He is the head of the body, which is the church. Everything comes from him. He is the first one who was raised from the dead. So in all things Jesus has first place. Colossians 1:18 (NCV)*

2. **My Mind** – “...Always be prepared...”

**Keep Learning about Your Faith so that you can clearly share!**

3. **My Mouth** – “...to give an answer to everyone...”

**Keep Talking about Your Faith in everyday conversation!**

4. **My Lifestyle** – “...who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have.”

**Keep Living out Your Faith so that people clearly see Jesus in your everyday life!**

5. **My Attitude** – “But do this with gentleness and respect...”

**Keep Loving & Listening so you earn the right to be heard!**
