Dear Fellow Librarians.

My prayer for your libraries is that each library you represent will Reach the lost, Teach the saved and Minister to all. Now to accomplish that you may have

to change or at least adjust what you are currently doing in your ministry. A library can be an excellent outreach tool to the community around your church.

I have just returned from a mission trip to Nicaragua. There were 22 members from my church on the trip. We broke up into teams of 3-4 along with 1 interrupter and 1 local church member and walked door to door in the community of Los Larious. When we arrived at the different homes the people welcomed us in, they stopped whatever they were doing and pulled out chairs for us to sit and allowed us to share the Gospel. Can you imagine that in the States. Here we would have doors shut in our face if 5 or 6 people just showed up. But if we can get the word out that our libraries are open to our communities and welcome them in, it would be possible to build a relationship with them and we could **REACH** them for the Lord, **TEACH** them God's word and **MINISTER** to their needs. Our libraries must change what we are doing. We cannot stay inside our church walls, just as our churches cannot hide inside the building. The ministry will die and so will the church if we do not find creative ways to reach a lost world.

Please make plans now to attend the annual Library Conference at Shocco Springs this year. We will be announcing some changes for next year's conference that I think will be exciting and I hope that you will be excited too!


