

SUNDAY SCHOOL DIRECTOR

The duties of the Sunday School Director will be different in individual churches. The Sunday School Director should be a person who . . .

- Is a faithful supporter of the pastor and church.
- Sets an example by living according the teachings of the Bible.
- Cares about people.
- Is committed to reaching people for Christ and ministering to others through the Sunday School.
- Is faithful in fulfilling their responsibilities.

The Sunday School Director works under the supervision of the pastor or other designated leaders. Some duties may include. . .

1. Work with others to enlist the workers and organize the classes. Help start new classes.
2. Insure that literature is ordered in cooperation with the church office.
3. Provide workers training and planning times. (May take workers to training events.)
4. Help in planning for outreach and ministry through the Sunday School.
5. Emphasize enrolling new people and discovering prospects.
6. Insure that accurate records such as enrollment and attendance are kept.
7. Keep the work of the Sunday School before the people during the year.
