## SUNDAY SCHOOL DIRECTOR

The duties of the Sunday School Director will be different in individual churches. The Sunday School Director should be a person who . . .

- Is a faithful supporter of the pastor and church.
- Sets an example by living according the teachings of the Bible.
- Cares about people.
- Is committed to reaching people for Christ and ministering to others through the Sunday School.
- Is faithful in fulfilling their responsibilities.

The Sunday School Director works under the supervision of the pastor or other designated leaders. Some duties may include. . .

- 1. Work with others to enlist the workers and organize the classes. Help start new classes.
- 2. Insure that literature is ordered in cooperation with the church office.
- 3. Provide workers training and planning times. (May take workers to training events.)
- 4. Help in planning for outreach and ministry through the Sunday School.
- 5. Emphasize enrolling new people and discovering prospects.
- 6. Insure that accurate records such as enrollment and attendance are kept.
- 7. Keep the work of the Sunday School before the people during the year.
