- Relates honestly to the Word, applying it to real life
- Relates humbly to the Body of Believers in service, generosity and love
- Relates lovingly to Family in caring faithfulness
- Relates graciously to Neighbors with ministry and compassion
- Relates boldly to the World as ambassadors for Christ

## ✤ Idea 2: As we strive to mature into Christ-likeness, we partner with God

- Personally through worship, prayer and absorbing Biblical truth
- Locally by connecting with and caring for our neighbors
- Globally by engaging the nations with the gospel, wherever we have opportunity.

## ✤ Idea 3: As the family of First Baptist Church, we desire to produce

- Followers of Christ, hungry to grow in their faith
- Humble people, living out their lives in accordance with Scripture
- Worshippers of the Living God who Honor Him corporately and personally
- Homes where marriages are strengthened, children are nurtured, and God is honored.
- Morally-pure lives that stand firm in an age of compromise
- People who are generous in giving, serving and caring
- Good neighbors, being salt and light in Prattville, Alabama
- Missional people, taking the gospel to the nations whether here at home or around the world.
