Tools Needed to Begin Bible Drill

Participating in Bible Drill will help children increase their love for and knowledge of the most important book in the world: the Bible. They will develop skills in using the Bible, develop memory skills, and learn how to apply the Bible to their everyday lives.

- WHO participates in drill? Children Grades 4, 5, and 6
- WHAT is learned in drill?
 - 1. <u>Books of the Bible:</u> Children learn the books of the Bible in the proper order and are able to locate them within 10 seconds.
 - 2. **Bible Verses:** Children memorize 25 verses and their references.
 - 3. <u>Key Passages:</u> Children learn the names and references of the key passages listed on the Verse Card and are able to locate the references in the Bible.
- MATERIALS used in teaching drill:
 - *Bibles: King James Version and Holman Christian Standard Version are the two versions used in Bible Drill. Drill Bibles are available through Lifeway.
 - *Bible Skills, Drills, and Thrills Curriculum: This curriculum is also available in the three drill cycles (Red, Blue and Green) from Lifeway. It will help children develop Bible skills and can help in the preparation of those in Children's Bible Drills. (These cycles are annual.)
 - *Children's Bible Drill Verse Cards: The verse cards for the current year and cycle are available online at www.alsbom.org/bibledrills.

➤ LEVELS of Drills:

Children who give 12 or more correct responses in the <u>Church Drill</u> are eligible to participate in the <u>Association Drill</u>. Children who give 16 or more correct responses in the <u>Association Drill</u> are eligible to participate in the <u>Regional Drill</u>.
