

How To Have A Daily Quiet Time With God

Just as in any relationship, your closeness to God depends on the time that you spend with Him! Below are some tips for developing a habit of daily time with God:

Be Intentional!

You must have a plan if you desire to grow closer to God. Your Quiet Time should include prayer, scripture reading, reflecting on what God is saying to you and what you should do about it. (A Quiet Time page is attached for you to duplicate as needed.)

Be Organized!

When you meet with the Lord, come prepared with your Bible, a pen and paper or a notebook.

Be Committed!

Try to meet at the same time each day so you develop a habit of spending time with God. For many people, first thing in the morning is the time when they are fresh and focused. You should also plan to meet in a place where you are not distracted by other people or things.

Be Creative!

Use variety in your approach to your time with God. Perhaps you will read through a book of the Bible, a few verses each day. Or maybe you will pursue a topical approach, searching out all the verses that deal with your chosen topic. You may also use the lyrics to praise songs and hymns to help focus your time on God.

Be Expectant!

Trust the Lord to meet you and to speak to you each time you get alone with Him! He desires that you know Him and spend time with Him!
